Target dates already passed:

WSSD: Establish a regular process for reporting (Global Marine Assessment) by 2004

WSSD: Prevent, deter, and eliminate illegal, unreported and unregulated fishing by 2004

WSSD: Implement the fishing capacity IPOA by 2005

Several of the WSSD goals and MDGs do not have targets or timetables. For example, WSSD Goal: Promote integrated ocean and coastal management at the national level, and MDG Target 9: Integrate the principles of sustainable development into country policies and programmes and reverse the losses of environmental resources.
